

De ereprijs is pleased to invite you to attend the very first performance of **ECO**, the European Contemporary Orchestra, on Saturday 4 June 2011 in the Arnhem City Hall auditorium.

On the occasion of this first performance, **orkest de ereprijs** will organize the first **Informal European Composers Meeting** on the same day in Arnhem. A meeting where you will meet other European composers and exchange ideas concerning possibilities and impossibilities of contemporary ensembles and orchestras.

Orkest de ereprijs (Apeldoorn), **Ensemble Télémaque** (Marseille) and **Musiques Nouvelles** (Mons) form the basis for this new 33-piece orchestra: **ECO**.

ECO offers the entire spectrum of colours we already encounter in the world of ensemble and symphonic music, but adds to it the more up-to-date aspects of pop, jazz, electronic and dance music: electric guitars, vocalists and strings, saxophones, keyboard and percussion – that is to say, drums. Where should **ECO** perform, what will it looks like, who writes for it, individually or as a composition team, are designers and cinemamakers also involved? You get the picture: too many questions to answer on your own; hence this invitation.

Following the first concert by this orchestra on 4th June 2011 with works by **Martijn Padding** and **Vladimir Tarnopolsky**, and two others concerts in 2012 in Marseille and Mons, we will tour the European Cultural Capitals with concerts on the agenda in Marseille (2013), Mons (2015) and, in 2018, a Dutch city or province (the city of Utrecht, province of Brabant or Friesland).

As a way of introducing the orchestra to composers, we offer you – in addition to the evening concert – a broad programme moderated by **Willem Hering**, former artistic director of the **Asko-Schönberg Ensemble**.
